Morse code identifiers

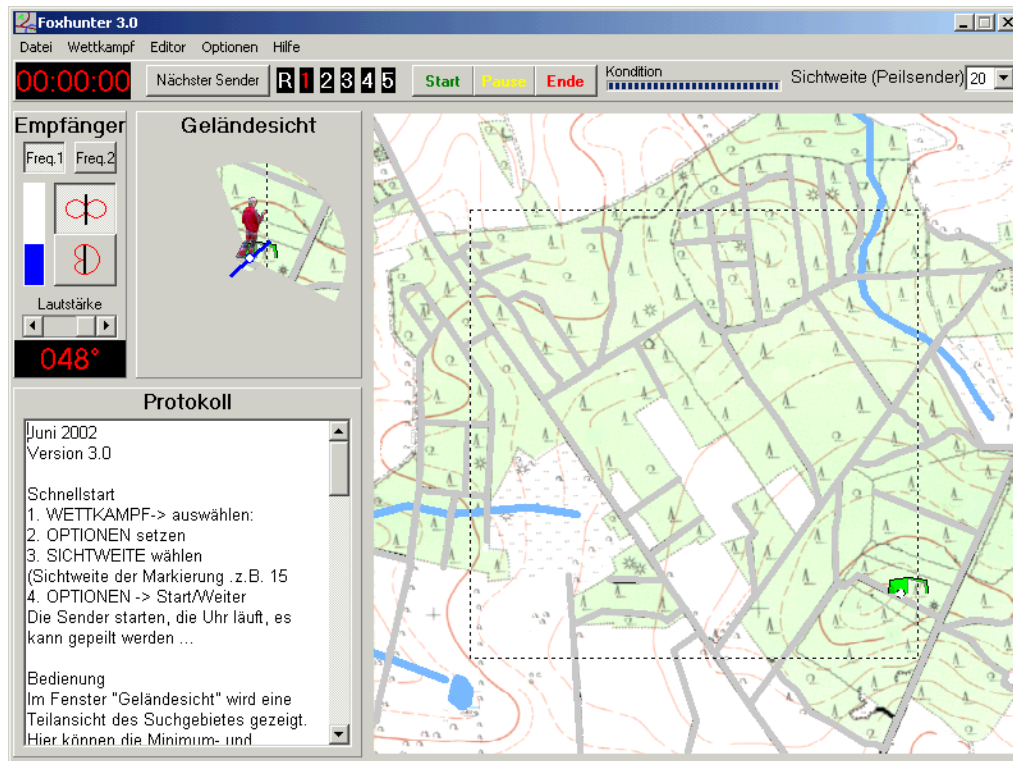
Fox hunt beacons are identified by morse code signals. Here are sound snippets to practice identifying them:

fox	call	code	recording

4	MOH	— — — — — ••••	[ogg] [mp3]
5	MO5	— — — — — •••••	[ogg] [mp3]
finish	MO	— — — — —	[ogg] [mp3]
